Bishop's Committee Report

July 2010

The Bishop's Committee met July 19 and heard reports on a number of ongoing activities and some new ones.

The Treasurer reports that payments have not been coming to cover the weekly ads in the Bee. The plan was that volunteers would sign up for one monthly payment of \$35, so that the ad can run each week all year long if there are twelve volunteers. There was a sign-up sheet on the bulletin board but it has disappeared, so we will start another one. Thanks to those who have already contributed, and now we hope for more volunteers.

The next Circles meal served by Holy Spirit will be August 24. The Walls will take charge of it, and two or three additional volunteers would be appreciated. Thanks again to the Creed-Clogg-Hackworthy team for serving the June 29 meal.

The Congregational Development Team (Creeds and Walls) has been meeting with The Rev. Paul Lebens-Englund to discuss possibilities for Holy Spirit's mission to our community. The team and the Bishop's Committee have been reading a book, *Missional Renaissance*, by Reggie MacNeal, to increase awareness of potential growth in our spiritual and community life. Others in the congregation are encouraged to buy or borrow a copy of the book in preparation for Paul's visit, August 29, when he will serve in dual roles – supply clergy and discussion leader. The Creeds have now left the team to make time for other obligations. The Walls will continue until the August 29 meeting, when others will be asked to join the effort.

The computer for the Marymount School in Ghana has been purchased, but the cost of shipping and adequate insurance is prohibitive. Other options are under investigation.

A new sign-up sheet will soon appear on the bulletin board. Please sign up for at least a week at a time for helping with incoming mail and telephone messages. Of course, if someone would volunteer to be church secretary, that would be even better.

Wine in the Pines will be held September 18 from 6 – 10 p.m. Enjoy tasting a large selection of wines and hearing an expert discuss wines of the Northwest. The wine and light buffet will be accompanied by the music of Dave and Tami Gunter and Rob Kincaid and Amy Craven. More details will follow as volunteers step forward to organize them.

Closely following, Oktoberfest arrives October 2. Bratwurst and local beer will once again be served, and local artists will also be able to display their work.

Wine and music followed by bratwurst, beer and beautiful works of art – what a great way to open our newly renovated space to the community!
